1. Volunteer Role & Scope of Services

- The Volunteer is participating on a voluntary and unpaid basis. Volunteers are not licensed professionals or certified contractors.
- Volunteers will make reasonable efforts to complete agreed-upon tasks to the best of their ability. However, they will not perform any tasks involving hazardous conditions or specialized labor, including but not limited to:
 - Electrical work
 - Major plumbing repairs
 - Heavy lifting or the operation of heavy machinery

2. Client Obligations

- The Client agrees to provide a safe, respectful environment for the Volunteer at all times.
- The Client understands that the services provided are limited in nature and scope. These services are intended solely to provide basic support that promotes independent living and are not a substitute for licensed or professional services.

3. Waiver of Liability and Release

- The Client acknowledges and accepts that the Volunteer is not liable for any unintentional or incidental damage, loss, or injury that may occur during the provision of assistance.
- The Camano Center, Opportunity Council and their affiliates, board members, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents shall be held harmless and are expressly released from any and all liability or claims for damages or injuries arising out of or related to services rendered through this program.

4. Right to Refuse or Terminate Services

- Volunteers reserve the right to decline or discontinue any task they believe to be unsafe, inappropriate, or beyond the agreed scope of services.
- Either party (Volunteer or Client) may choose to terminate the service interaction at any time and for any reason, without penalty.
